



E.M. THARP INC. /WORLD AG EXPO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Deadline for Scholarship Application: February 1, 2021– 5:00 p.m.

The E.M. Tharp Scholarship will be awarded based on eligibility as outlined in the criteria below, as well as the quality of the application. Grades and financial need will be assessed but are not the only factors considered when awarding the scholarship. If the applicant is selected for an interview, they must bring a professional photo of themselves to the interview. Scholarship winners will be contacted prior to the World Ag Expo Online Show in February.

The grant will be sent to the university the recipient will be attending in the fall. The recipient of the scholarship must spend the grant within 12 months of award date for tuition, fees, books or other education-related expenses. Failure to use the scholarship within 12 months or use of the scholarship for any purpose other than educational expenses will result in the recipient needing to refund the full amount of the scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Officially graduate from high school during the 2021-2022 school year
- Acceptance by an accredited 4-year university, if not accepted yet provide which universities you have applied to at this time.
- Future educational and vocational career goals must be related to agriculture
- Applicant must reside in Madera, Fresno, Tulare, Kings or Kern counties
- Completion of scholarship application, including transcripts and letters of recommendation

Incomplete, hand written, or late applications will not be accepted.

Application Process:

- Complete application, including letters of recommendation and transcripts, prior to deadline of February 1, 2021. Must receive application by deadline date, not postmarked.
- Provide a transcript of high school grades and ACT or SAT scores. (Please do NOT provide original transcripts in sealed envelopes or folded) **ACT/SAT Scores are NOT MANDATORY this year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.**
- Provide two letters of recommendation
- Do NOT: Fold Application, Send Application in Small Envelope, or Portfolio/Folder.
- Submit **two unstapled copies** of your scholarship application; including transcripts and letters of recommendation to:
