



"World Ag Expo We Believe in Growing Scholarship sponsored by Coast Counties, Peterbilt"

Deadline for Scholarship Application: January 16, 2026–5:00 p.m.

The scholarship will be granted based on the applicant's eligibility as outlined in the criteria below, along with the overall quality of the application. While academic performance and financial need will be reviewed, they are not the sole determining factors in the selection process.

Applicants selected for an interview must bring a professional photo of themselves to the interview. Scholarship recipients will be notified prior to the World Ag Expo in February.

The scholarship funds will be sent directly to the university the recipient plans to attend in the fall. These funds must be used for educational expenses such as tuition, fees, books, or other related costs.

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating high school senior during the 2025–2026 academic year.
- Have been accepted to an accredited four-year university. If not yet accepted, please list the universities to which you have applied.
- Demonstrate a clear intent to pursue educational and career goals related to agriculture.
- Reside in one of the following California counties: Madera, Fresno, Tulare, Kings, or Kern.
- Submit a completed scholarship application, including official transcripts and letters of recommendation. Note: Incomplete, handwritten, or late applications will not be accepted.

Application Process

To ensure your application is considered, please follow these steps:

- Submit a completed application—including transcripts and letters of recommendation—by January 16,
 2026. Applications must be received by the deadline (not postmarked).
- Include high school transcript and ACT or SAT scores. Do not submit original transcripts in sealed envelopes or folded.
- Provide two letters of recommendation.
- Mail your application in a 9x12 envelope, unfolded.
- Submit two unstapled copies of the complete application packet, including transcripts and letters of recommendation, to the following address:
